

**INFORMATION REGARDING THE NATURALIZATION CEREMONY AT THE
CHAIFETZ ARENA ON THE CAMPUS OF SAINT LOUIS UNIVERSITY ON FRIDAY,
SEPTEMBER 19, 2008**

Petitioners taking the Oath of Citizenship on September 19, 2008, are expected to arrive at the Chaifetz Arena at the time indicated in the correspondence sent from the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service Office (beginning at 11:00 a.m.).

It is necessary for Petitioners to check-in and participate in a very brief final interview during which they will sign their certificates, name change forms and turn in their green cards and other documents as required by the USCIS officers. If a petitioner arrives late and does not go through this final interview process, he or she will NOT be able to take the Oath of Citizenship on September 19, 2008 and his or her oath ceremony will have to be rescheduled.

The actual Court proceeding, during which the petitioners will be naturalized, is scheduled to begin promptly at 2:00 p.m.

Friends and family members may not want to arrive as early as petitioners, as there will be several hours between check-in and the actual Court ceremony.

Limited, stadium-type food and beverages will be on sale at the arena concession stands. The campus of Saint Louis University will be equipped with signage to direct petitioners and their guests. There will also be student volunteers to assist visitors.

Parking will be available at the Olive Parking Garage located at the corner of Olive and Compton. (see map on back) There is a \$5.00 parking fee to be paid when you enter the garage. This entitles you use of the garage for the entire day, including in-and-out privileges.

A drop-off location on Compton Avenue, in front of the Arena, is provided for the elderly and the disabled.
