ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the local rules of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Missouri are amended, subject to approval of the Eighth Circuit Judicial Council, by adding new rules **3 - 2.10, 11 - 2.11, 5 - 2.12, 83 - 2.13, 6 - 2.14 and 83- 2.15** as set forth in the document appended to this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Local Rule 7- 4.05 is amended as follows:

(A) The filing and briefing of a motion for judgment on the pleadings, motion to dismiss and motion for summary judgment shall be subject to this rule only if a Case Management Order so provides. [New text added]

~~(A)~~ (B)(1) Except appeals under the Social Security Act and cases in which any party is appearing pro se at the time a motion is filed, motions for judgment on the pleadings, motions to dismiss and motions for summary judgment in civil cases otherwise subject to Rule 4.01 shall be filed with the clerk of court only when presented as a package consisting of the motion, the response of each party who has entered an appearance in the cause and the movant's reply memorandum, if any. ~~This rule shall apply to motions for judgment on the pleadings, motions for summary judgment and motions to dismiss filed on or after August 1, 1998.~~

Existing subsections (B), (C) and (D) of Rule 7 - 4.05 are redesignated as subsections (C), (D) and (E) respectively.
