

PROCEDURE FOR POST-PLEA/POST-SENTENCING MOTIONS

RELATING TO BOND

A. Bond Revocation

Bond revocation petitions that are submitted after a defendant pleads guilty or is sentenced are to be presented to the district judge assigned to the case. If the district judge is unavailable to handle the petition, it will be referred to the magistrate judge who set the bond. If the magistrate judge who set the bond is unavailable, it will be referred to the duty magistrate judge.

B. Bond Modification

Requests to modify conditions of release that are made after a defendant pleads guilty or is sentenced are to be presented to the district judge assigned to the case.

The Pretrial Services Office will be notified of these new procedures.
