ORDER

Defendants have moved for approval of a cash bond and for a stay of execution of two judgments entered following bellwether trials. The proposed cash bonds appear appropriate and so I will grant the motions to deposit funds. I will also grant the motions to stay execution, which will become effective upon defendants' posting the bonds.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendants' motions to deposit funds with the court [## 3207, 3209] are granted, and defendants may deposit cash bonds into the Court Registry in the amounts of \$2,308,590.74 for the first bellwether trial and \$1,537,171.91 for the second bellwether trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall deposit the funds in an

interest bearing account or instrument.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendants' motions to stay execution on judgment [##3206, 3208, 3242, 3243] are granted, effective upon payment of the cash bonds into the Court Registry.
