Public Notice

Prohibited Items

The Federal Security Committees of the Eastern District of Missouri, in cooperation with the United States Marshals Service and Federal Protective Services, provide this notice of prohibited items from courthouse facilities of this District. All visitors (including contractors, attorneys, and visiting public) are prohibited from bringing items listed into the confines of a federal courthouse in the Eastern District of Missouri or upon the surrounding grounds of said facilities.

Liquids and Beverages

(excluding those required to serve child care, medical, or other special needs or as otherwise authorized by a presiding judge for a specific proceeding)

Cameras and/or Recording Devices

(without prior approval, see [Electronic Device Policy](#))

Firearms and Projectile Weapons

(firearms, stun guns, ammunition, replica or toy firearms)

Bladed, Edged, or Sharp Tools

(axes, knives, sabers, swords, daggers, utility knives, box cutters)

Club-like Items and Striking Devices

(night sticks, brass knuckles, martial arts weapons)

Destructive Devices, Explosives, or Combustible Chemicals

(dynamite, fireworks, flammable liquids)

Disabling Chemicals

(mace, pepper spray, tear gas, spray paint)

Any attempt to bring a prohibited item(s) on the grounds or inside the confines of a federal courthouse in the Eastern District of Missouri will result in confiscation and destruction of such item(s). Violators are subject to arrest. This public notice will be posted at the entrance of all District facilities and on the Court's webpage at www.moed.uscourts.gov. Changes to prohibited items can be made upon majority approval of the Facilities Security Committees without further notice.
