ORDER

The Court held the first monthly status conference in this case on August 10, 2026, via Zoom videoconference. The parties' respective lead and liaison counsel submitted an agenda in advance and reported to the Court on the status of preliminary discovery, the proposed timeline for the filing of a consolidated complaint and responsive pleadings, and the existence of any unconsolidated cases.

To summarize, now that a protective order is in place (Doc. 46), the TriZetto Defendants intend to produce later today the discovery identified in the Court's order defining the scope of preliminary discovery. (Doc. 34). The deadline for this phase of discovery is August 20, 2026, after which Plaintiffs request 30 days to file a consolidated complaint. To account for any service delays and new parties and claims, Defendants request 60 days to file Rule 12 responsive pleadings. The Court will afford any additional named defendants an opportunity to provide input regarding liaison counsel at an appropriate time to be discussed further at the September status conference.

Counsel for the healthcare provider Defendants reported that there are at least five and likely more unconsolidated state court cases, some involving small non-profit or publicly funded providers. The parties agreed to work together on a proposed order addressing unconsolidated cases.

Accordingly, as further discussed on the record,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following schedule shall apply:

1. The deadline for preliminary discovery remains **August 20, 2026**.
2. Plaintiffs shall file a consolidated complaint by **September 21, 2026**.
3. Defendants shall file any Rule 12 responsive pleadings by **November 20, 2026**. Plaintiffs shall respond within **30 days**. Defendants shall reply within **15 days**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file a proposed order addressing unconsolidated cases by **August 21, 2026**.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that the next monthly status conference is scheduled for **September 14, 2026, at 1:30 p.m.** via Zoom video conference using the credentials previously circulated.
