ORDER

WHEREAS the President of the United States and the Judicial Conference of the United States have declared that the emergency provisions of the CARES Act, P.L. 116-136, 134 Stat. 281 (CARES Act) expire on May 11, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Judicial Conference of the United States has permitted remote audio public access to civil and bankruptcy proceedings through September 21, 2023;

NOW THEREFORE, effective May 11, 2023:

- 1. The Court terminates its <u>February 10, 2023 Order</u> in re. Case Operations and all prior Orders related to COVID Case Operations; and
- 2. The Court authorizes remote audio public access to its civil proceedings through September 21, 2023, subject to the discretion of the Presiding Judge in any particular civil case.
