Administrative Order No. 1

Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, Title <u>18 U.S.C. § 3006(a)(1)</u> and <u>(c)</u>, the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Eastern District of Missouri is hereby appointed to represent any defendant previously or currently determined to be entitled to appointment of counsel and who has been included on the list provided by the United States Sentencing Commission of those persons estimated to be eligible for sentence reduction under Part A of Amendment 821, to determine whether or not that defendant may qualify to seek reduction of sentence and to present any motions or applications for reduction of sentence under <u>18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2)</u> in accordance with 2023 Sentencing Guideline Amendment 821. Should the Office of the Federal Public Defender determine that there is a conflict with regard to the representation of a particular defendant, the Clerk of the Court is authorized to appoint a member of the Criminal Justice Act panel of this Court.

The Court orders that all motions and pleadings seeking a sentence reduction or in opposition to such a reduction will be filed in the original criminal proceeding. If the sentencing Judge in the original proceeding is no longer a member of the Bench of this District, the case shall be reassigned.

The Court further orders that the Federal Public Defender shall promptly enter its appearance on behalf of such defendants or identify those defendants for whom they have a conflict, in which case CJA counsel will be appointed. In any event, defendants nonetheless have the right to retain counsel at

their own expense. A schedule for motions, reports, and briefs regarding any request for a reduced sentence will be entered by separate Order.
